MEASURING & JUMP HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog if your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during the day of show check-in. However, it is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.*

MOVE-UPS

All pre-show move ups The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. You may send an email for a move-up to agilityaddict@msn.com with your name, your dog's call name, the name & date of the trial and what class you want the dog to be moved to. Day-to-Day Move-ups: Move-ups from day-to-day at a set of back-to-back agility trials shall be at the discretion of the club. The request to move up must be made in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary not later than the day preceding the event. It is permissible for an exhibitor to request a day-to-day move-up in person for the following day on a trial day of which he/she did not show their dog. The exhibitor may have someone else on-site fill out/sign the form as their representative.

There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show, provided the Trial Secretary receives them within 15 minutes after the end of the last class. There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial. EXCEPTION: A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from the Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class. Move Down: After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in its class level (i.e. Master to Excellent). The request must be in writing and submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place - Blue, Second Place - Red, Third Place - Yellow, Fourth Place - White

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title, while quantities are available. A MACH rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH. A PACH rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their PACH. A flat green ribbon will be awarded to all dogs that earn a qualifying score. All prizes, awards and ribbons must be picked up before the end of the show. No ribbons, etc., will be mailed after the show.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The ATFTC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The ATFTC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the ATFTC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. This club does not agree to arbitration as stated on the AKC Entry Form.

REFUNDS

No refunds will be given for overpayment of \$6.00 or less.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, a public emergency, act of a public enemy, weather or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

If an entry was made online, no refund of the service fee will be refunded for any reason.

Refunds for injured dogs or handlers: 50% refunds will be given for a dog or handler that has a note from their veterinarian or doctor saying they cannot participate in the show. The doctor's appointment must have been before the show.

Full Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date/ time. However, online convenience fees will not be refunded for any reason.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds. As such, the club will issue full refund minus \$5.00 processing fee for bitches unable to compete for this reason if the **Trial Secretary receives** WRITTEN notice of withdrawal no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the first class.

Change of judge: If the judging assignment changes **a**fter the distribution of the premium list, an exhibitor has the right to request a full refund of their entry fees for any class affected. Exhibitors must submit requests in writing to the Trial Secretary a minimum of 30 minutes preceding the start of the event on the first day the exhibitor is entered.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs of 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners Listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, nor will aggressive dogs, bitches in season, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Action Dog Sports, Stone Pony Ranch, WWDAT - Agility Trial Best Practices

As we navigate and celebrate the safe reopening together, We want to take a moment to express our deepest gratitude to all our incredibly supportive students, exhibitors, clubs and volunteers. The following set of rules and guidelines were constructed using CDC and AKC guidelines for the safety of our officials, volunteers, students and exhibitors.

We will be adhering to them at Action Dog Sports for all classes, facility rentals and events.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation and stay well- Julie & Daneen

GENERAL: Exhibitors entering Agility trials held at Action Dog Sports/Stone Pony Ranch must comply with all Federal, State and Local laws. Anyone who is ill or not feeling well for any reason **must stay home**. Entering an agility trial at any time is done entirely at your own risk. If a Club suspects an exhibitor is ill, they will ask for that exhibitor to leave trial grounds immediately.

PARKING: Parking will be spread out (depending on type of vehicle, back door or side door). We will need to use our best responsible judgement.

CRATING: Outdoor crating from your car will continue to be our primary means of crating. Suggestions for outdoor crating: Bring a shade tent or screens to go over your car. Also stock up on batteries for crate fans.

SPECTATING: No spectators permitted. Only the exhibitors entered in the trial are allowed on site. We are trying to keep numbers down.

<u>MASKS:</u> All exhibitors must supply their own masks and must take ALL PPE items home with them. Do NOT use site trash cans for PPE items.

IN THE (Trial Secretary Room): NOBODY but the Trial Secretary and judges are allowed in the trial secretary building and a 6 foot distance from the door will be maintained.

<u>OUTSIDE ON TRIAL GROUNDS:</u> Masks are required if physical distancing of 6' or more feet is not possible. Exhibitors will need to bring enough masks for the duration of the trial and dispose of single use masks properly. The Clubs and/or Action Dog Sports will not be supplying masks. Whether exhibitors are required to wear a mask while they are running their dog, will be decided on an event to event basis.

<u>GLOVES</u>: Gloves are an individual choice. If as an exhibitor, you prefer to wear gloves, you will need to bring enough for the times you will need to wear them. Please take all PPE items home with you and DO NOT use site trash cans to dispose of them.

RING CREW:

BAR SETTERS: Hand sanitizer will be used BEFORE and AFTER changing the bars. You may use your own chair in the ring.

If using an ADS provided chair in the ring, then please wipe it down after your volunteer session is complete.

LEASH RUNNER: Per AKC rules, exhibitors may place leashes in their pockets or wear them when running the course. Leash must fully fit in the pocket. If an exhibitor chooses not to run with their leash, they have the choice to place a second leash on the fence by the exit gate and take their dog in the ring with another leash, the handler will remove the leash and hang it over the fence by the entry gate. WE WILL NOT HAVE LEASH RUNNERS. Handler must collect the leash at the entry gate in a reasonable time.

<u>TIMER / SCRIBE:</u> The scribe will be the only person handling the scribe sheets between themselves and the secretary. Scribe will check the order of the scribe sheets against the running order prior to the start of the class. There will be appropriate physical distance at the score table between the Timer and Scribe. At the completion of the class, the Timer will wipe down the timer box.

<u>GATE STEWARD:</u> There will be tape indicating the safe space around the gate steward. Exhibitors should not enter this space. . If any additional markings on the run order sheets are required, only the gate steward may write on them. Gate steward will dispose of run order sheets when the class is complete and wipe down the gate board.

ENTER / EXIT TO THE RING: We will be implementing a chute style gate area. You are asked to immediately leave the ring area after your run is complete. Please reward your dog (treats / toys) at your crate / car area.

OTHER ITEMS:

GATE BOARDS / CHECK-IN: Runs orders will be displayed on gate boards as usual.

We will be staggering the check -in and running of the different heights.

So for example we will run small in the morning and then tall in the afternoon. We will alternate small to tall and tall to small run orders on multiple day trials. Exhibitors will walk, then run for example - Standard, Jumpers, and Games, and then leave so that we have only the very minimum amount of people at one time.

BRIEFINGS: Excellent / Master level classes will not have briefings. During briefings for all other class levels exhibitors are not required to be inside the ring for the briefing. They may spread out to maintain appropriate physical distancing.

COURSE MAPS: Course maps will be posted as per AKC regulations. There will be two posting areas of all courses to enable appropriate distancing of exhibitors when viewing the map. Paper copies will not be provided. It is recommended that exhibitors take photos of the maps with their phone / iPad etc. If available from the judge, the course maps will be emailed to the exhibitors the evening before, or the morning of each trial day.

<u>WALK-THRU GROUPS:</u> We will walk in a safe manner. You will have plenty of time to walk. You must maintain 6' between competitors. You must keep moving. No stopping and chatting on course. You must continue to the exit. When you want to walk again - go to the entrance gate and start again. Reminder: masks are required at all times during the walk-thru.

GATES: We will have chute style gates. Gates will stay open for competitors to exit the ring after their run, and during the walk-thru.

TRIAL RESULTS: Results will be posted on the table for viewing. Please do not gather in groups around the results, maintain a line to approach them, take pictures of results and then please move on. Reminder: your individual results are emailed to you after the trial.

RIBBONS: Qualifying stickers / ribbons will be self-serve. Hand sanitizer will be available and MUST be used BEFORE and AFTER touching the result book or ribbon box. Reminder, please maintain appropriate physical distance while in line for your awards.

<u>FOOD:</u> There will <u>not</u> be a lunch buffet, nor snacks, water or beverages provided to exhibitors Please plan and pack accordingly for yourself and your dog/s.

Per AKC, no MACH cakes allowed.

SANITIZATION:

HAND WASHING: Not only now, but always, washing hands and not touching your face decreases the spread of germs. Continual hand-washing throughout the day is encouraged. The restroom area will provide a wash station, hand sanitizer and paper towels for drying. It has also been suggested that you can keep a supply of sanitizing wipes in a Ziploc bag on your person. That way, you always have a wipe with you, can be used a few times, and it stays moist!

OVERALL CLEANING: The facility will be disinfected prior to the start of the trial. All public surfaces (gates, fencing, door handles, tables etc.) will be wiped down periodically throughout the trial day. Hand sanitizer will be available on numerous tables throughout the facility.

These guidelines may be adjusted / updated during the weekend, if necessary, for improvement.

Thank you for your support. Your patience and understanding is appreciated. Please keep in mind that we are doing our best to keep everyone safe, we want to see everyone enjoy this time with their dogs. Be sure that you are comfortable with these guidelines. If anyone does not abide by these, they will be asked to leave the trial with no refund. With everyone's cooperation and help, the trial day can run smoothly and we can continue to participate in a dog sport we all love!

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other

dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and <u>may not</u> compete in a jump height division <u>higher or lower</u> than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
